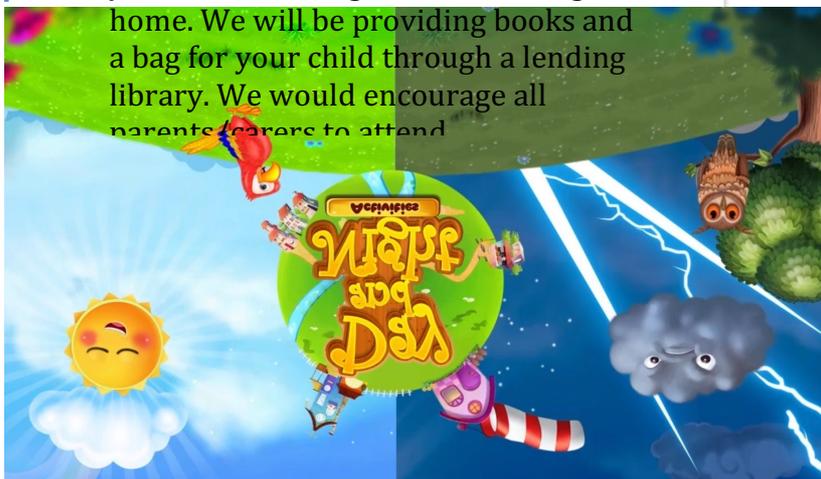
November 2018 Pre-School Newsletter
